

WORLD TAEKWONDO 2025 SUSTAINABILITY AWARDS

Introduction

In 2022, World Taekwondo (WT) took a step further on its sustainability journey by developing a new Sustainability Strategy. The strategy includes an implementation plan based on three focus areas:

- Diversity, Equity & Inclusion (DEI) and Community
- Environmental Sustainability (ENV)
- Health & Well-being (HNW)

Objectives have been established for each focus area, with accompanying actions planned across the organisation, its events, and throughout the global Taekwondo family. One of those actions is a Sustainability Award, held annually at the end of the year to celebrate the valuable contributions of Member National Associations (MNAs) through the sport to global sustainable development goals.

Why apply?

Many MNAs are already doing excellent work in sustainable development, and we wish to make sure that everyone can share in their experiences and take advantage of the know-how in the Taekwondo family for the benefit of society and the environment.

In addition, MNAs stand to gain visibility and recognition for their achievements:

- All eligible applicants will have their initiatives listed on the WT Awards webpage.
- All shortlisted finalists (3 from each award category, 9 in total) will have a description of their initiatives on the webpage.
- All shortlisted finalists will receive support from WT in their communication efforts to promote their awards and nominations.

Win an award and be a recipient of the WT Development Programme:

The winner from each category will receive an award and be invited to apply for USD 5,000 in value-in-kind support through the Development Program for 2026. WT will inform the winners regarding the required documentation for the Development Programme in early 2026.

Application process

 An online application process will open on June 2, 2025. The application process will close on September 12, 2025.



- WT will inform MNAs via email and also make an announcement on the WT website.
- Applicants are invited to apply for more than one focus area / award category (with additional actions, not the same one).
- Applicants will be asked to respond to a questionnaire; questions will be the same across all three focus areas.
- Jury members will consist of a sub-group of WT Sustainability Committee members (not able to vote for submissions in their own country and continent) and other experts as appointed by WT.
- Applications must come from MNAs, regardless of whether the action was conducted in partnership with another entity.
- The action must not have been completed more than three years before this application deadline.
- The application must be submitted via an online platform with the completed data required by the stated deadline. A link to the online platform will be sent to the MNAs.
- If the application and data are not in the same languages used in the WT MNA Survey (English, French, Arabic, and Spanish), the MNA is required to submit a translated version.
- An MNA may only submit a winning action once. That action cannot be submitted in the following year(s).
- Actions that have not won may be resubmitted in the following year(s) as long as the MNA specifies how the action has changed since the previous submission.

Award criteria

An application must showcase a good practice in one of the three Focus Areas. As part of the application form, we invite the applicants to provide the following information:

- Focus Area
- Name of the action
- Summary of the action, including why it was needed and what it aimed to achieve
- Key performance indicators that were used to measure impact
- Unique attributes of the action and potential for transferability
- Challenges faced
- Lasting impact and how it aligns with the MNA's sustainability efforts
- Approach to communication
- How the award will strengthen the action and support future development

Evaluation process

- WT will assess the eligibility of the applications based on the eligibility criteria outlined above, under 'Application Process'.
- Jury members will then rank each of the applications by scoring each one across predefined criteria, including but not limited to:
 - Sustainability impact
 - Transferability and potential for adaptation

- Strategic alignment
- Use of award and future development
- The top three ranked applications within each focus group will be debated among the jury to ensure confidence in the final ranking, and to decide on an overall winner.

Timeline

12 September 2025	Deadline for submission of applications
19 September 2025	Collated applications sent to Jury for individual evaluation
8 October 2025	Jury meets to decide on winners from each focus area and overall winner
