## **Appendix - Examples of Good Governance Practice 2022-23**

The table below presents a compilation of good governance practices from WT MNAs that participated in the MNA Survey 2022. These practices were identified after the governance review conducted by WT.

All the examples below relate directly to the 25 questions in the MNA Survey 2022 and are numbered accordingly. To be included, the MNA usually demonstrated that it fully met the specific criteria. Despite the existence of examples of good governance practice in various languages, to ensure accessibility and comprehension for all members, the selected examples were limited to those available in English and accessible through the MNAs' website. Therefore, it should be noted that the examples provided are not necessarily the best in each category, and the exclusion of any specific MNA example should not be interpreted as any kind of criticism.

MNAs interested in learning from or emulating the provided examples should evaluate whether and to what extent they are relevant to their specific situation. It is acknowledged that replicating some of the structures and procedures listed may be impractical for certain MNAs due to resource constraints. Note that the examples presented for each indicator are not ranked in any particular order. Lastly, as governance practices evolve, the webpages and documents referenced in the list may be updated or replaced. This document should be periodically reviewed to ensure that the links remain available.
