1. Introduction

1.1. Objectives

The objectives for the 2024 WT Olympic Solidarity Camp encompass a collaborative effort between World Taekwondo (WT) and the International Olympic Committee's (IOC) Olympic Solidarity (OS) Team, with a strategic focus on several key areas.

1.1.1. Collaborative Organization of the 2024 WT Olympic Solidarity Camp:

In a concerted effort, WT and the IOC's OS Team will collaborate to organize the 2024 WT Olympic Solidarity Camp. This joint initiative aims to seamlessly combine the expertise and resources of both organizations.

1.1.2. Focus on Africa and Enhancement of Athletes' Competitiveness:

The camp places a particular emphasis on Africa, centralizing efforts to enhance the competitive capabilities of athletes from member national associations. This targeted approach aims to prepare athletes for successful participation in the upcoming Dakar 2026 Youth Olympics and Los Angeles 2028 Olympic Games.

1.1.3. Preparation and Administrative Support:

WT Member National Associations (MNAs) play a pivotal role in providing necessary administrative support during the preparation phase. This involves confirming participation through the Africa Taekwondo Union (AFTU) and ensuring smooth communication for the attendance of invited athletes and coaches.

1.1.4. Hosting in Senegal:

Dakar, Senegal, has been chosen as the venue to host the 2024 WT Olympic Solidarity Camp, extending a warm welcome to athletes from 9 surrounding countries. The focus is on creating an inclusive environment that fosters talent development, skill enhancement, and active participation.

1.1.5. Overall Focus on Talent Cultivation, Skill Enhancement, and Active Participation:

The overarching goal is to concentrate efforts on cultivating talent for the Dakar 2026 Youth Olympics and Los Angeles 2028 Olympic Games. This involves prioritizing skill enhancement to ensure athletes are well-prepared for these prestigious events, coupled with encouragement for proactive participation to foster a sense of engagement and commitment.

1.1.6. Prospect for Future Programs:

The camp seeks to identify and nurture the potential of promising athletes, with plans to develop future programs aimed at maximizing the potential of these identified talents.

1.1.7. Contribution to Global Taekwondo Development:

Through dedicated talent development initiatives, the camp aspires to contribute significantly to the global advancement of Taekwondo. This involves preparing athletes to excel on the international stage, thereby making a positive contribution to the overall growth of Taekwondo





worldwide.

1.1.8. Invitation Details

Therefore, World Taekwondo extends invitations to **two (2) male youth athletes (under the age of 17), two (2) female youth athletes (under the age of 17), and one (1) coach from each respective country for the upcoming 2024 WT Olympic Solidarity Camp. Camp check-in is scheduled for May 19th, and check-out is on May 30th. Airfare will be pre-paid by each National Association and reimbursed accordingly. The reimbursement process for airfare will be conducted within the designated budget for each country. Further details will be provided by World Taekwondo in the forthcoming communications.**

1.2. Expectations
