Α. **Qualification & Experience in Taekwondo**

- I have been practicing the Art of Taekwondo for the Last 10 years and have reached milestones such as gaining my Black Belt, and most recently Qualifying for the 2020/21 Tokyo Olympic Games. I am the first Female to ever Qualify for the Olympics in the Sport of Taekwondo for our tiny Island Kingdom of Tonga. This achievement was through the ongoing support and encouragement of our National Federation, Coach, Officials and Family. With this achievement, I am so Overwhelmed and Humbled. I sincerely hope that it will set an example for Young Women in Tonga and the Pacific Region to empower them with their dreams to never give up and keep on going despite all the odds.
- Through this Olympic Journey, I have gained Experience on the International Stage, competing in the Australia Open in 2019, as Well as winning a Bronze Medal at the South Pacific Games in Samoa – 2019 for Individual Female fighter, and Gold for Female Team Fight. Adding to this List is winning the Gold medal at the Olympic Qualification Tournament for Oceania Region for Tonga.

- Throughout the years I have been involved with various Sports in Tonga, such as Netball and Rugby at different levels. I have represented Tonga in the Female Rugby 7's in 2019 in Fiji after the South Pacific Games.
