## Background

The World Taekwondo Federation (WTF) has initiated an innovative host city selection process which will allow the WTF to enter into a dialogue with potential bidders ("Partners") in order to ensure that the WTF Events fit into a city's long-term development agenda.

In this sense, the WTF organizes the Partnership Workshop under the theme of "WTF Events, Why and How Bid?" to provide an opportunity for the WTF and potential bidders to understand and clarify each other's expectations and objectives from the earliest stage.

The workshop will cover following 34 WTF Events between 2017 and 2021 which are open to bid.
