Resolution

Tunisia in 06/1998

The Minister of Youth and Sports

After reviewing law No. 104 of 1994 of 03 August 1994 concerning the organization and development of physical education and sports activities, especially chapter 29 thereof.

And Basic Law No. 11 of 1995 of 06 February 1995 on sports structures.

The following resolution shall be issued:

Chapter 1: The Ministry of Youth and Childhood has created a mixed committee for the organization.

Chapter 2: The Mixed Organizing Committee shall coordinate between the various interlinked structures in the sports sector to ensure the smooth conduct of weekly sporting events in various disciplines and categories, both organizational and security.

Chapter 3: The Mixed Organizing Committee, chaired by the Director of Civil Sports or its representatives from the following structures, shall be composed of the following administrations:

- Elite Sports Management
- General Directorate of Intervention Units
- National Civil Protection Office
- General Directorate of the National Guard

- Security Department of the territory of Tunisia
- Regional Security Department
- Management of the National Sports District
- Greater Tunis Municipalities
- National Center for Sports Medicine
- National sports universities
- Regional Delegates for Youth and Childhood in Tunis, Ariana and Ben Arous.

The members of the Committee shall be appointed by a proposal from the relevant structures and departments.

Chapter 4: The Mixed Organizing Committee shall hold its meetings on a regular basis on Monday every week at the Ministry of Youth and sports (General Directorate of Sport) throughout the sports season.

Chapter 5: The Committee's work shall be recorded by a minutes of the session to be submitted to the Minister in charge of sport and the concerned parties.

Chapter 6: This decision shall come into effect from the sports season 1998/1999.

Security measures are also being strengthened during major international sporting events such as international and continental competitions and major prizes organized in Tunisia through:

- ✓ Strengthening the security presence in the area hosting the event.
- ✓ Providing security escort for participating delegations (athletes, trainers and officials) during their internal travel and in their place of residence.
- ✓ Personal escorts for VIPs during their presence in Tunisia on the occasion of the demonstration.
- ✓ Strengthening the security focus of the perimeter of the sports facility where the events are held.
