



GUIDELINES ON 2019 DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

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INTRODUCTION

WT Development Program is designed to support its stakeholders such as Continental Unions, MNAs, athletes, coaches and grassroots level to build their own capacities. 2019 WT Development Program consists of 5 areas as follows.

1. MNA Equipment Aid
2. MNA Participation Aid
3. Booyoung Athlete Scholarship
4. Booyoung MNA Grassroots Development
5. Continental Union Development Fund

To be eligible for applying for any of these support programs, the MNA must have paid the WT annual membership fees of 2017, 2018 and 2019.

MEMBER NATIONAL ASSOCIATION EQUIPMENT AID

Overview

1. The Equipment Aid is designed to provide the required sport equipment to the MNAs to support training and/or organization of competitions.
2. Qualification
 - Host cities of events in the official WT event calendar
 - MNAs who have not applied for equipment aid in 2018
3. Amount
 - US\$5,000 per MNA
 - Maximum 20 MNAs
4. Timeline and Process
 - Due to the limited fund allocated to this support program, WT will select the MNAs on a first come and first serve basis.
 - The attached application forms must be fully filled out and submit to Member Relations & Development by no later than June 30.
 - The applied MNAs will be requested to adjust the applications in coordination with WT and suppliers.

MEMBER NATIONAL ASSOCIATION PARTICIPATION AID

Overview

1. The MNA Participation Aid is designed to support participation of MNAs in the 2019 WT General Assembly and Manchester 2019 WT World Taekwondo Championships.
2. Requirements
 - a. MNA Official(s)



- Attendance of a minimum of one (1) of MNA officials at the 2019 WT General Assembly
- b. MNA Athletes
 - Participation of a minimum of one (1) of MNA athletes in Manchester 2019 WT World Taekwondo Championships (*Registration without presence is not considered as participation.)
- 3. Qualification
 - a. This program is not for all MNAs in general but is for the MNAs selected by WT based on the studies of financial capabilities of the MNAs.
- 4. Amount
 - a. US\$6,000 per MNA
 - b. Maximum 35 MNAs
- 5. Timeline and Process
 - a. WT will contact the selected MNAs in March to introduce the program together with the application form.
 - b. The MNAs shall complete the application form and send it to Member Relations & Development.
 - c. Upon verification of actual participation, WT will remit the financial support to the MNAs by June 2019.

BOOYOUNG ATHLETE SCHOLARSHIP

Overview

1. The Individual Athlete Scholarship, funded by Booyoung, is designed to support resources for athletes and/or Para taekwondo athletes to help their training and participation in competitions.
2. Requirement
 - a. Applications must be submitted by MNAs, CUs, WT Regional Training Centers and WT-recognized organizations.
 - b. If the application has not been submitted directly through MNA, the application should be approved by applicant's MNA.
 - c. For balanced distribution of the fund, each applying organization is limited to recommend a maximum of two (2) athletes.
3. Qualification(qualified applicants who satisfy one of the following four criteria)
 - a. Refugee athlete
 - b. Para-Taekwondo athletes
 - c. Athletes training at WT-recognized training centers or facilities
 - d. Athletes ranked within top 50 of World Kyorugi Ranking, World Poomsae Ranking and World Para Kyorugi Ranking
4. Amount
 - a. Maximum US\$5,000 for 15 athletes and 5 Para-athletes
5. Timeline



- a. Announcement
 - June 1, 2019
- b. Deadline to apply
 - July 31, 2019
- c. Screening and allocation
 - From July 31, 2019

BOOYOUNG MNA GRASSROOTS DEVELOPMENT

Overview

1. MNA Grassroots Development Program, funded by Booyoung, is designed to support grassroots taekwondo training in the less-developed MNAs by dispatching an instructor to carry out taekwondo training (short-term/mid-term/long-term) to educate local instructors and practitioners.
2. Requirements
 - The MNAs shall complete the application form and submit to Member Relations and Development. Upon review the application, WT will decide whether this program will be applied to the applying MNA.
3. Qualifications
 - a. MNAs which have less than 25 registered numbers of GMS
 - b. MNAs with WT annual membership fee of US\$300
 - c. MNAs which is exempted from GMS fee

CONTINENTAL UNION DEVELOPMENT FUND

Overview

1. The Continental Union (CU) Development Fund is designed to support Continental Unions to carry out their operations as well as development program for MNAs in their continents, particularly for Para taekwondo. The allocation will be made into 2 phases.
 2. Requirement for the 1st phase
 - A. 2018 Finance Report (audited by CPA)
 - B. 2018 Operations Report
 - C. 2019 Business Plan
- *The official guidance of the 2nd phase of CU Development Fund will be announced in due course.
