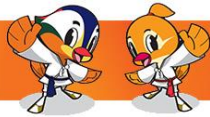

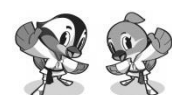
1. Preface

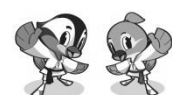

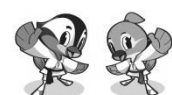

2. Accreditation and Validation

2019 Chungju World Martial Arts Masterships Organizing Committee will distribute the accreditation card (ID card) to the confirmed participants who complete payment for accommodation fees. ID card will be available to the entry listed presenter with the passport. Only participants showing the ID cards can access to the venue and Athletes' Village.

Accreditation center will be operated at the main competition venue (Chungju Gymnasium), Family Hotel (HQ Hotel) and the main ITO hotel (3 places) from August 26, 2019 to September 6, 2019 (12 days). In case of lost or damage of ID card, documents and passport (or passport copy) are required to re-issue the ID card.





3. Immigration and Visa

Exclusion to the entry without visa based on the agreement of visa exemption, visa issuance to the concerned embassy or consulate at least 60 days before entry. Organization committee will provide visa issuance invitation to the participants after received invitation application with confirmation of the president of the national federation by date 30 June 2019 for a smooth progress.

4. Transportation

4.1 Transport Services for Arrival and Departure

Shuttle Bus Services will be provided for arriving and departing athletes and team officials, depending on arrival and departure information and flight schedule.

4.2 Transport Services for Competitions

Shuttle Bus Services for athletes and team officials participating in competition will be provided between Athletes' Village and the competition venues as per the competition schedule.

4.3 Transport Services for Training

Shuttle Bus Services for athletes and team officials participating in competition will be provided between Athletes' Village and the training venues as per the training schedule.

4.4 Transport Services for Spectating

The AV-to-venues shuttle will be provided to athletes and team officials wishing to watch other sport competition events. The service is also available to all athletes and team officials who are involved in the same events: priority, however, will be given to athletes and team officials participating in their own events.

4.5 Transport Services for Luggage

The luggage belonging to athletes and team officials should, in principal, be loaded onto the bus they take. If not possible due to insufficient storage space, another vehicle will be provided to the destinations.



5. Accommodation

During the competitions time, athletes and team officials will be accommodated at the Athletes' Village located in Chungju. The check-in at the Athletes' Village will be available from two days before the competition, and check-out will be one day after the competition. For the sake of the safety, separate signage is required for entering the area.

6. Media

6.1 Press Center

The press center will be set up in the Chungju Sports Complex to support interchanging between athletes and media, interview activity at site and control requests and providing convenient space.

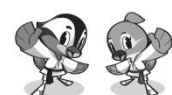
6.2 Mixed Zone

The Mixed zone is an area in which athletes may be interviewed as soon as they leave the field of play. The Mixed Zone is designed to permit the broadcasters and press to interview athletes in a designated area near the field of play. In accordance with WMC's rules, all athletes must pass through the Mixed Zone. Mixed Zone interviews are recommended within limited time each to let the broadcasters and press to have an equal opportunity to speak to the athletes.

The 2019 Chungju World Martial Arts Masterships Organizing Committee will provide all necessary assistance to ensure the convenience of Mixed Zone.

7. Medical Service

Medical stations for athletes will be installed at all competition venues with stand-by medical team and ambulances. On-site medical treatment and emergency transfer service will be provided during operating period.

8.2 Chungcheongbuk-do in brief

Introduction to Chungcheongbuk-do

As the central city of Korea, the inland highway, Mt. Taebaek at its north, Mt. Sobaek at east, Mt. Charyeong at northwest, those all pass through Chungcheongbuk-do. It is hot and humid during the summer, cold and dry during the winter with clear four seasons. As it is closed to Seoul, the capital city of Korea, economy, education and culture have highly developed with the convenient traffic conditions. It has shown the larger economic growth than the other areas with big development of high-technology industry such as bio, beauty & cosmetics, solar, new energy and semiconductor industries etc. as well as has intensively fostered new industry like AI, hydrogen energy, secondary battery etc. to lead the fourth industrial revolution.

Transportation

Seven different highways including Gyeongbu, Jungbu and Jungbunaeryuk Expressway are passing through, and Gyeongbu train line at southwest, Center train line at northeast, and Chungbuk train line are running from northeast to southwest. It also has the best transportation infrastructure and the great accessibility from everywhere in Korea within two hours with the location of KTX Osong station as the only intersection of Gyeongbu and Honam high-speed railroad, as well as Cheongju International Airport as the key airport of central area.

Area and Location

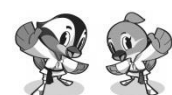
The area is 7,407km², and the location is at longitude 127°16'-128°38', latitude 36°00'-37°15'

As of January 2019, 1,638,729 (including registered foreigners) people and 708,227 household live in Chungcheongbuk-do.

Touristic Resources

Chungcheongbuk-do enjoys natural tourist attractions like Chungju Dam, Daecheong Dam, Mt. 8.3 Chungju in brief

Introduction to Chungju

Chungju is located at the center of Korea and northeast of Chuncheongbuk-do. It is an intermountain basin surrounded by Mt. Gyemyeong, Worak, Kukmang and Cheondung, and has abundant water resources as the Namhan River and Yodo Brook flow through Chungju. As the heart of the Jungwon cultural area, it also has an abundance of historical cultural inheritance and natural resources such as mountains, hot springs and lakes. Chungju is the birthplace of Taekkyeon, which is the 76th intangible cultural asset of Korea, and has been hosting the World Martial Arts Festival every two years. As a mecca of martial arts, it has the HQ of the World Martial Arts Organization (WMAO), UNESCO International Center of Martial Arts and Chungju World Martial Arts Park. It has been developed as a harmonized city of urban and rural based on the growth of culture, tourism, and eco-friendly agriculture as well as high-technology industry including bio-health and hydrogen-fueled cell vehicle components.

Transportation

It has a cross-road traffic network by Jungbu Naeryuk and Pyeongtaek Jecheon Expressway, and the Chungbuk train line is passing from northeast to southwest of Chungbuk. The Jungbu Naeryuk train line is also under construction to be completed in 2021. Chungju has a great accessibility from every area of Korea with its central location and high-speed traffic network.

Area and Location

The area is 984km², and the location is at longitude 127°39'-128°08', latitude 37°47'-37°12'.

Population

As of January 2019, 215,865 (including registered foreigners) people and 93,292 households live in Chungju.

Touristic Resources

Chungju enjoys natural touristic attractions including mountains, hot springs, lakes and rich touristic resources of Jungwon culture. Famous tourist spots are Mt. Worak, Suanbo Spa, Angsung Spa, Chungju Lake, Chungju World Martial Arts Park, Jungangtap Park, Tangeumdae Terrace, Chungju Goguryeo Stele Exhibition Center, Mireukdaewon Stone Temple Site etc. More detailed information on Chungju tour will be found at <https://www.chungju.go.kr/tour>

6. Competition Rules

The Taekwondo competition of the 2019 Chungju World Martial Arts Masterships will be held in accordance with the World Taekwondo (WT) Competition Rules. In case of any disagreement in the language interpretation of the rules and regulations, the English version shall prevail. Any unforeseen cases not covered by the regulations and rules shall be resolved as follows:

- General issues: Resolved in accordance with the WMC Constitution and Rules
- Technical issues: Resolved in accordance with the WT Rules and Regulations



7. Competition Format

7.1 Competition Method

7.1.1 Kyorugi

Mixed Gender Team Kyorugi competition of the 2019 Chungju World Martial Arts Masterships is G-1 team ranking event.

The 1st place team shall be given the right to compete in the Mixed Gender Team Kyorugi event, which is adopted as a showcase event of Taekwondo for the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games. Preliminary rounds may carry out by either single elimination or round robin system depending on the final number of entries. The winners of semi-finals will advance to the final contest, and the losers of the semi-finals will receive the bronze medals.

In order to form the mixed team, each team must enter 2 female athletes and 2 male athletes. Weight range is as follows.

- The total weight of 2 female athletes shall be 135kg or less
- The total weight of 2 male athletes shall be 160kg or less.

Mixed Gender Team Kyorugi competition of Taekwondo in the 2019 Chungju World Martial Arts Masterships consists of 3 rounds (4 minutes of 1st round, 3 minutes of 2nd round & 3rd round) with 1 minute break between rounds.

- The 1st round (4 minutes) shall be conducted based on traditional team match format for one minute per competition in the order from lighter to heavier. Final score of each team shall be total accumulated points scored by all athletes of the team.
- The 2nd round shall start with choice of Chung's female athlete and 3rd round shall start with choice of Hong's female athlete based on tag-team match format for 3 minutes, and the other side must match same gender for every bout. The unlimited numbers of replacement shall be allowed but must stay in minimal 15 seconds before every replacement.

The team that scores more points in accumulation of the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd round shall be declared as the winner, in case of tie score after all 3 rounds, golden round shall be carried out on tag-team format, the team that scores the first four points shall be declared as winning team.





7.1.2 Poomsae

Poomsae competition of the 2019 Chungju World Martial Arts Masterships will consist of Free Style Poomsae competition. G1 Poomsae ranking point shall be awarded to the only male and female individual events.

Free Style Poomsae competition shall be conducted cut-off system. The contestant ranked first in the standings after the final round receives the gold medal and the contestant ranked second receives the silver. Two bronze medals are awarded to the contestants ranked third and fourth in the final round.

In Poomsae competition in the 2019 Chungju World Martial Arts Masterships, each contestant can participate up to a maximum of 2 events. Divisions are as follows:

- 18-30 Individual (Male and Female)
- 18-30 Pair (Mixed)
- 18-30 Team (3 Males and 3 Females)

The winner shall be the contestant who is awarded more points in total. In case of a tied score, the following procedure will be used.

- The winner shall be the contestant who has more points in technical skills.
- In case the score are still tied, then the one who has higher total points (total points of all judges, including highest and lowest points) is the winner.
- If it's still tied then a rematch shall be conducted to determine the winner. The same Poomsae that each contestant has already performed shall be performed again.
- In case of a tied score after the rematch, presentation points shall be a priority. If the presentation points are still tied, the winner shall be the contestant who is awarded more points in total, including the highest and lowest scores that were not included in collection of scores.

7.2 Competition Venue

In the Kyorugi competition, competition area will be square shaped of the size 12x12m. At the center of the competition areas, the octagonal-shaped contest area of the 8m in diameter will be placed.

In the Poomsae competition, 12x12m (team event) and 10x10m (individual and pair event) of square shaped competition area will be placed.

7.3 Competition Duration

In all contests of Mixed Gender Team Kyorugi shall be carried out for 3 rounds (4 minutes of 1st round, 3 minutes of 2nd round & 3rd round) with 1 minute break between rounds.

Free Style Poomsae of Individual, Pair, and Team competitions shall be performed from 60 seconds to 70 seconds. The waiting period between Poomsae is 30 to 60 seconds.



8. Sport Entries

8.1 Eligibility

- Only WT member National Federations are entitled to send athletes who are officially approved by WT to participate in the Taekwondo competition of the 2019 Chungju World Martial Arts Masterships.
- Only athletes who comply with the WMC Constitution and Rule and Bye-law are entitled to participate in the Taekwondo competition.

8.2 Entry Timeline

- Entry by Number - Deadline: 24:00 July 12, 2019 (Korea Time, GMT +9)
- Entry by Name - Deadline: 24:00 July 29, 2019 (Korea Time, GMT +9)

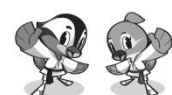
8.3 Entry Policies

- Each National Federation may enter 1 athlete in Individual Free Style Poomsae event.
- Each National Federation may enter 2 athletes (1 Male+1 Female) in Pair Free Style Poomsae event.
- Each National Federation may enter 1 team each in the Team Free Style Poomsae and 1 team (male 2, female 2) in the Mixed Gender Team Kyorugi event.

※ Age Limitation

- In Kyorugi competition, only athletes of 17 years and older are eligible to participate. (December 31, 2002 or before)
- In Poomsae competition only athletes of 18 years and older and under 30 years of age are eligible to participate. (December 31, 2001 – January 1, 1989)

- ※ The number of officials per each National Federation or Association is not able to exceed 50% of the number of athletes.

The necessary Technical Officials and Appeal Commission of Taekwondo competition in the 2019 Chungju World Martial Arts Masterships shall be appointed by WT with approval by the WMC and WMOC.

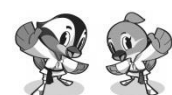
12. Protests and Appeals

In case there is an objection to a referee judgment in free style poomsae competition, an official delegate of the team must submit an application for re-evaluation of decision (protest application) together with the non-refundable protest fee of US\$200 to the Board of Arbitration (Competition Supervisory Board) within 10 minutes after pertinent contest. Deliberation of re-evaluation shall be carried out excluding those members with the same nationality as that of contestant concerned, and resolution on deliberation shall be made by majority. After reviewing the protest application, the contest of the protest must be arranged according to the criterion of "Acceptable" or "Unacceptable". The resolution made by the Board of Arbitration (Competition Supervisory Board) will be final and no further means of appeal will be applied.

13. Equipment and Clothing

Equipment used and clothing worn by athletes and other relevant participants in the Taekwondo competition must comply with the WT regulations and rules. Participating athletes are required to use his or her own uniform and other personal equipment which qualify to the international standard during the competition.

Neither athletes nor technical officials can attach any form of commercial advertising to his or her competition uniform without prior agreement with WMC, WMOC and WT.





KPNP Protector and Scoring System (PSS) including PSS Headgear will be used for the Kyorugi competition in the 2019 Chungju World Martial Arts Masterships. In the Kyorugi competition, participating contestants are required to wear WT-recognized doboks and WT-recognized protective equipment. Participating contestants are required to bring their own groin guards, mouthpieces, gloves, sensing socks and shin and forearm guards for their personal use. Any contestant who wears unofficial doboks or protective equipment will not be permitted to compete. Participating contestants in the Poomsae competition are required to wear WT-recognized Poomsae doboks.

All Coaches are required to wear formal suit or official costume during the competitions.

14. Doping Control

Doping Control during the 2019 Chungju World Martial Arts Masterships will be conducted in accordance with WT Anti - Doping Rules and will follow the standards and procedures laid down by the WADA.

15. Victory Ceremony

Gold, silver and two bronze medals will be awarded to the athletes/teams ranked top three of each event respectively. Fifteen minutes before the victory Ceremony starts, the medalists shall be escorted to the waiting area to get ready for the ceremony. Medalists must wear their National Federation's official uniform. Translation services will be provided with English and Korean during the victory ceremony.

16. Media Interview

All athletes should pass through the Mixed Zone. Athletes and/or coaches should attend press conferences and interviews when there are interview requests for them.

17. Sport Information Center (SIC)

All sport-specific information for Taekwondo will be available at the sport information desks. They are located at the competition venue and at the Sport Information Center (SIC) in the Athletes' Village.

18. Approval of the Technical Handbook

The Technical Handbook for Taekwondo has been approved by the World Taekwondo (WT) on April 30, 2019.

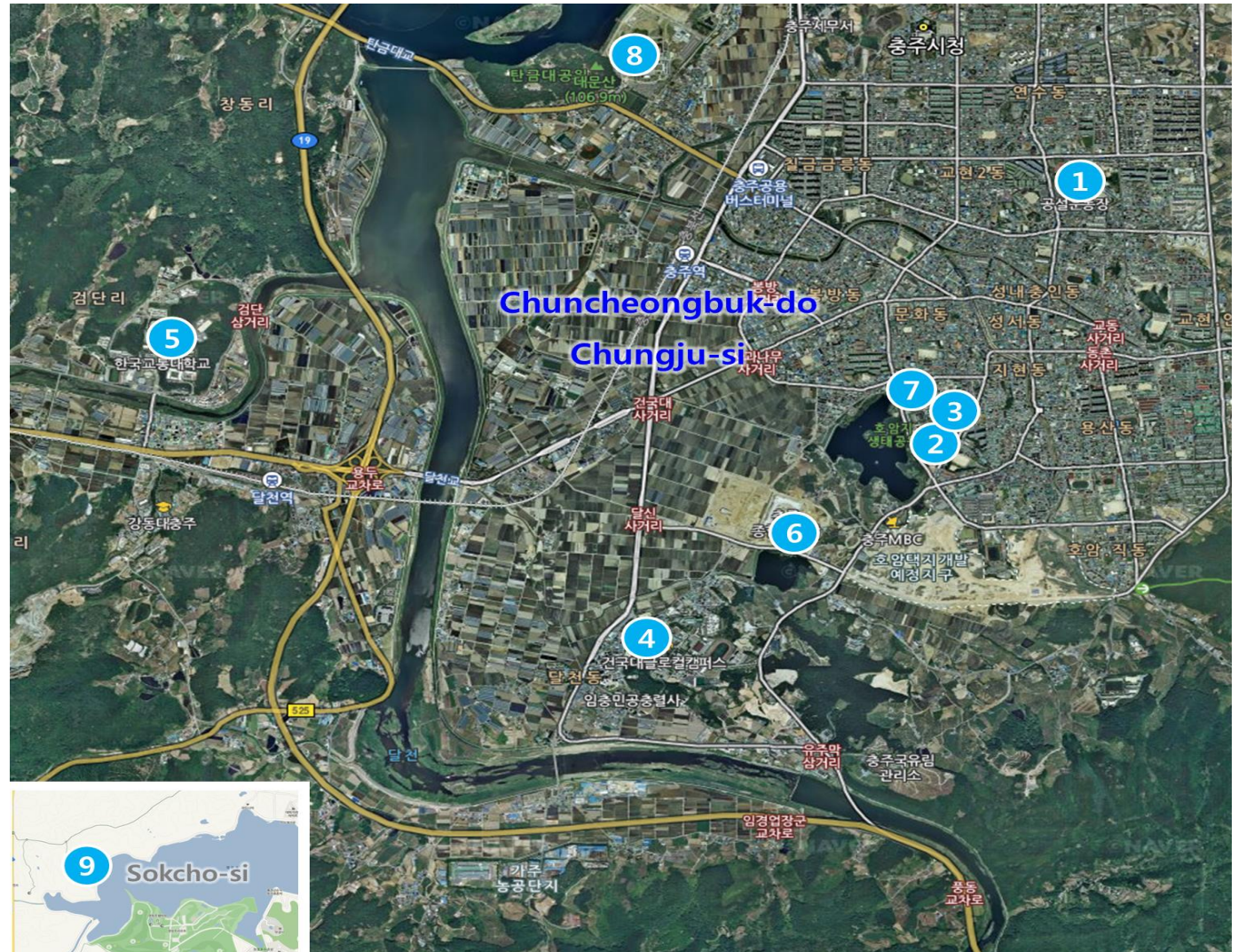
