Article 1 Purpose of the Event

- 1.1 Based on Resolutions of the World Taekwondo Council Meeting in Muju, 22nd of June, 2017, the World Taekwondo promotes [®]The World Taekwondo Grand Slam Champions Series (below Grand Slam Champions Series, or Grand Slam Series) in order to facilitate development of WT championship events as a popular and commercially valuable sports content in world wide.
- 1.2 The World Taekwondo expects to develop a proper model of Taekwondo championships more suitable to media and audience through operation of The Grand Slam Champions Series. To realize the purpose of the event the WT may utilize various resources and ideas including modification of the Competition Rules, equipment, and operational procedure.

Article 2 Ad-hoc Committee for Grand Slam Champions Series

- 2.1 To manage the Grand Slam Champions Series effectively the WT Council Meeting decided to form

 The
 Ad-hoc committee for the World Taekwondo Grand Slam Champions Series.
- 2.2 The Ad-hoc Committee shall have a chair and three vice chair and no more than 8 members.
- 2.3 The ad-hoc Committee shall have three sub-committees; technical games committee, operational committee, TV and commercial committee. Each committee shall have a chair, two vice chairs, and no more than seven members.
- 2.4 The President of the WT shall appoint chair, vice chairs and all members of Ad-hoc Committee, and appoint all chairs of sub-committees. Chair of sub-committee may recommend vice chair and members to the President.
- 2.5 The Ad-hoc Committee may research and explore various ideas and methods to develop the best format of the Grand Slam Champions Series, and report to the president to implement the results.
- 2.6 The Ad-hoc committee consults and supervises the Organizing Committee for the preparation process. And the Ad-hoc committee manages the operation of the series.
- 2.7 The Ad-hoc Committee shall report the results and evaluation of the Series to the president and the Council at the end of the year's events.

Article 3 Organizing Committee and Grand Slam Series Partner

- 3.1 To operate the Series successfully the World Taekwondo contracted with the World Taekwondo-Jijin Sport Culture Co. LTD.(WTJJ) as the Partner of the Grand Slam Series. WTJJ with TKDW, a sub-contractor of the WTJJ as the Partners of the WT Grand Slam Series shall be responsible for financial resource and budget for the Series over all.
- 3.2 The Local Organizing Committee shall be formed in cooperation with WTJJ, TKDW, Wuxi city, and the Jiangsu Provincial Sports Bureau. The Organizing Committee is responsible for preparation of the event including personal and material resource, and arrangement of transportation and accommodation. The Organizing Committee shall comply and cooperate with the Ad-hoc Committee in preparation and operation of the events.
- 3.3 The Partner, WTJJ and TKDW and the Organizing Committee shall report the results and related statistics of the Series to the Ad-hoc Committee at the end of the year's series.

Article 4 Formation of the Series

- 4.1 Weight Category: The Grand Slam Series shall consist of 4 categories in each male and female equivalent to the Olympic weight category. The weight category of the world Championships shall be consolidated as male -54kg and -58kg into -58kg, male -63kg and -68kg into -68kg, male -74kg and -80kg into -80kg, -87kg and +87kg into +80kg, and for female; -46kg and 49kg into -49kg, -53kg and -57kg into -57kg, -62kg and -67kg into -67kg, and -73kg and +73kg into +73kg. If a competitor cannot be the consolidated category, he/she shall lose the qualification status.
- 4.2 Method of Competition: Method of competition shall be the single elimination tournament. There shall be a bronze medal contest.
- 4.3 Qualification of competitors and seeding rules

- 4.3.1 The numbers of competitors in each weight category shall be 12 competitors for 2017 series and 16 competitors for 2018 and 2019 series 4.3.2 The Competitors who shall be qualified for the 2017 Series and the order of the seeding are as follows: Seeding The winner of 2016 Olympic Games in the weight category The winner of 2017 WT World Taekwondo Championships in the heavier weight Seeding #2 category in the consolidated category The winner of 2017 WT World Taekwondo Championships in the lighter weight Seeding #3 category in the consolidated category #4 The winner of the 2017 Grand Prix Final Seedina Seeding #5 The winner of the 2017 Grand Prix Series 1 Seeding #6 The winner of the 2017 Grand Prix Series 2 Seeding The winner of the 2017 Grand Prix Series 3 #7 Seeding #8 The winner of the 2016 Grand Prix Final
 - There are four wild cards Competitors; three from the Open Qualification tournament and one from the host country recommendation. Their seeding order shall be as follows:
- Seeding #9 1st place of Qualification Tournament
 Seeding #10 2nd place of Qualification Tournament
 Seeding #11 3rd place of Qualification Tournament

Seeding #12 Competitor recommended by the Host country

- 4.3.3 The Competitors who shall be qualified for the 2018 Series and the order of the seeding are as follows

- 4.3.5 In case that a competitor won more than one qualification status in the above list, he/she shall be seeded in the higher seeding position among them. And any seeding position vacant due to the competitor shall

be filled up by the next seeding competitor and next vacant position shall be filled up by the same manner. Any seeding position unoccupied after all required adjustment of the seeding shall be filled those competitor(s) who are in the highest position in the WT Olympic Ranking. In case that there are more than two unoccupied positions, the third position and forth position shall be filled by the competitor(s) who are recommended by the WT Technical Committee.

Article 5 Competition Rules and Equipment

- 5.1 Competition Rules: The World Taekwondo Competition Rules and Interpretation shall be applied for the WT Grand Slam Champions Series. However for the purpose of the Grand Slam Champions Series the Ad-hoc Committee may modify parts of the WT Competition Rules and Interpretation. The Ad-hoc committee shall obtain approval of the modification by the WT Technical Committee before the announcement of the modification of the Competition Rules and Interpretations.
- To realize the purpose of the Grand Slam Champions Series, modified and/or new design of uniform and/or equipment may be adopted for the Competition. Adoption of modified or new uniform and/or equipment shall be approved by the WT technical Committee before the announcement.

Article 6 Qualification for the 2020 Tokyo Olympic Games

- The top ranked athlete in each weight category on merit points standing of WT Grand Slam Champions Series after the Grand Slam Champions Series in January 2020 will qualify one (1) quota place each for their NOC for the Olympic Games.
- The qualification of the 2020 Tokyo Olympic Games shall be subjected by the Qualification System Games of the XXXII Olympiad Tokyo 2020 which set by the IOC and WT.
- 6.3 To determine the best player of the Series the rules of awarding "Points of Merit" are set as follows:

- In order to receive merit points, athlete must complete at least one (1) contest in Qualification Tournament.
- Up to two (2) decimal points will be counted in calculation of merit points.

- In order to receive merit points, athlete must complete at least one (1) contest in Grand Slam.
- Up to two (2) decimal points will be counted in calculation of merit points.
- There will not be any replacement quota for Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games from World Taekwondo Grand Slam Champions Series, when the first placed athlete of merit points standing is ranked within top five (5) of same weight category of WT Olympic ranking that reflected result until Grand Prix Final 2019.

- In the case of tie accumulated merit points standing, the athlete who competed more number of World Taekwondo Grand Slam Champions Series including qualification tournament is higher ranked athlete.
- There won't be any transfer of merit points when athlete changes in weight category of World Taekwondo Grand Slam Champions Series.
- 6.7 During cycle of World Taekwondo Grand Slam Champions Series (2017-2019), points will be deducted after each completed year by 25% of the initial points.
- 6.8 All merit points shall be reset as zero (0) in prior to next cycle of World Taekwondo Grand Slam Champions Series (2021-2023)

Article 7 Open Qualification Tournament

- 7.1 Open Qualification tournament for the World Taekwondo Grand Slam Champions Series shall be G2 graded Championships in the world Taekwondo Event Calendar. So in general the event shall be governed by all the World Taekwondo rules and regulations on the G-graded championships.
- However the Ad-hoc committee may allow athletes from other federations and/or other types of martial arts and in the case the Committee may allow different protocol of registration to the event. The Committee shall publicize the registration process for the different federation(s) in the outline of the event.
- 7.3 The third place shall be determined through the match between two losers of semi-finals.
- 7.4 The calculation of ranking point shall be the same with other G2 event.

Article 8 Scheduling of Competition

The date of the competition shall be after the completion of the year's Grand Prix Final and detailed schedules of the competition shall be decided according to the OC and the Host Broadcasting Company. The competition should be completed no later than the end of January of the next year.

Article 9 Prize Money

- 9.1 The winner, 2rd place, and 3rd place of competitors shall be awarded medal, certificate, and prize money. The amount of the prize money shall be determined and announce in the outline of the Series in each year.
- 9.2 The prize money shall be apportioned to the competitor and to the coach, 70% to the competitor and 30% to the coach.

Article 10 Arbitration

- Arbitration on all matter of the competition and technical issues shall be subjected to the decision of Competition Supervisory Board. The CSB shall consist of a chair and one vice chair and three members and all CSB members shall be appointed by the WT President.
- 10.2 Matters other than competition or technical issues shall be subject to the "World Taekwondo Dispute and by law".
